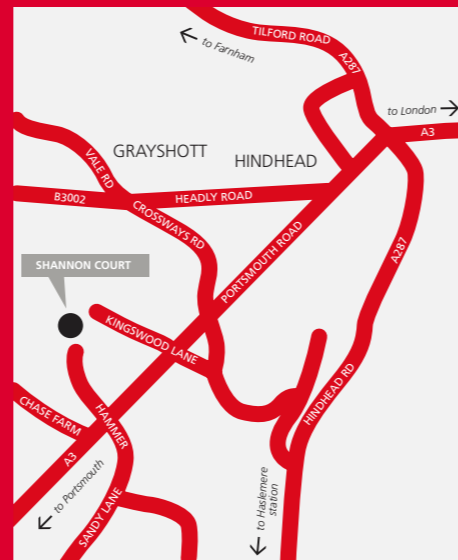
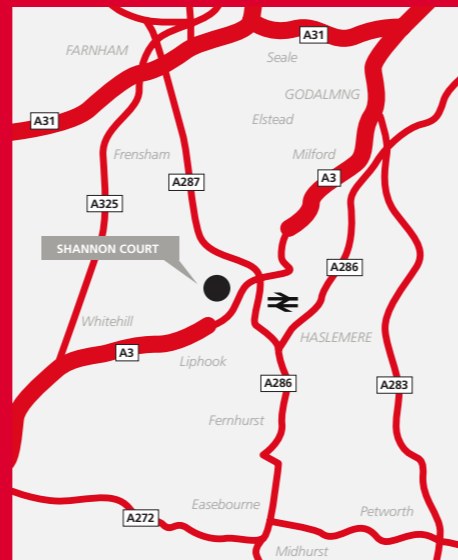
How to find us

By train
Liphook - 4 miles
Haslemere - 4 miles

By car
From the North
Take A3 south through Guildford to Hindhead. At Hindhead traffic lights (junction A287) continue south on A3 for 1½ miles. Pass B3002 on right, Crossways Road on right, High Pitfold on left and Kingswood Lane on right.

The Home is on the right just before the start of the dual carriageway. You cannot turn right at the Home. Enter dual carriageway and immediately take the right-hand lane. Turn right across central reservation and take A3 north. Shannon Court's drive is the first turning on the left.

From the South
Take A3 north through Liphook to end of dual carriageway at Hindhead. Pass Chase Farm turning on left, Shannon Court's drive is the next turning on the left.

A tastefully renovated Edwardian country home which stands in nine acres of peaceful woodland. The Home is close to the South Downs with its breath-taking areas of outstanding natural beauty. The grounds are laid out for the enjoyment of residents, with a woodland walk, ornamental fishpond and sensory garden.

Shannon Court is registered for residential and dementia care with the dual benefits of individual rooms and shared communal areas. The categories of care offered are dependent upon people's assessed individual needs.

Here is a snapshot of our services at Shannon Court:

General facilities and services available

The whole premise of the RMBI is to create a home rather than an 'institutional style' environment, both inside and out. Shannon Court can accommodate 53 residents, offering residential and dementia care. All rooms are single occupancy with ensuite facilities and are centrally heated, with TV and telephone points.

On each corridor there are bath/shower facilities especially adapted for safe usage so that residents maintain their independence in a safe environment. Kitchenettes are available where residents can make drinks and snacks for themselves or their visitors.

There are two special Dementia Support Units, the Alvernia Wing and the Ronald Davis Wing, catering for residents with dementia.

The Alvernia Wing is set in its own enclosed gardens and each Wing has its own lounge, dining room, kitchen and bath/shower facilities.

Health and personal care

Shannon Court offers a wide range of recreational facilities including a well stocked library with a full range of books to suit many needs. A full programme of activities is organised by our Activities Co-ordinators and includes bingo, quizzes and day trips to various places of interest. Entertainers also visit regularly for shows and concerts.

The Home has its own hairdressing salon where residents can enjoy haircuts and pampering from a professional hairdresser.
