Liverpool - 8 miles

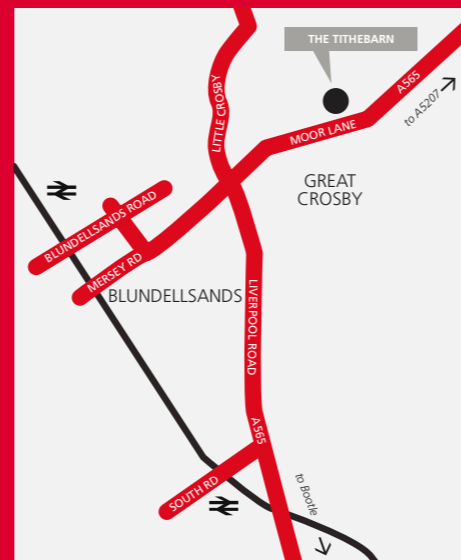
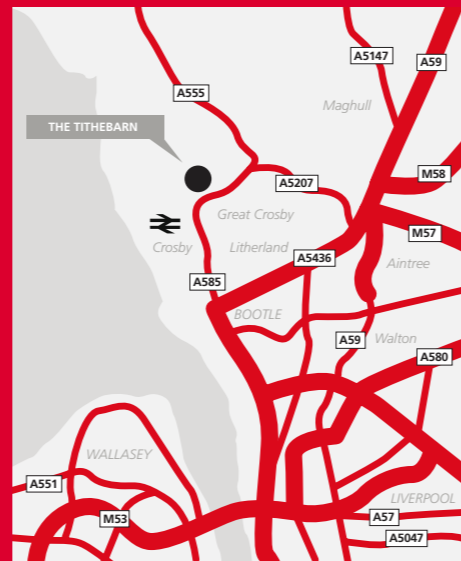
By car

From the North

Exit M6 at Junction 26. Take M58 to the end of the motorway. Take the A5207 to junction with A565 to Crosby. Turn left at traffic lights on to A565 (pub on right). Continue on A565 through traffic lights (approx. 2 miles) A565 becomes Moor Lane. Just after church on left and Poplar Avenue on right, turn right into the Home.

From the South

Exit M6 at Junction 21A. Take M62. Exit M62 at Junction 6. Take M57 to the end of the motorway. Take the A5207 to junction with A565 to Crosby. Turn left at traffic lights on to A565 (pub on right). Continue on A565 through traffic lights (approx. 2 miles). A565 becomes Moor Lane. Just after church on left and Poplar Avenue on right, turn right into the Home.

Here is a snapshot of our services at The Tithebarn:

General facilities and services available

The whole premise of the RMBI is to create a home rather than an 'institutional style' environment, both inside and out. The Tithebarn can accommodate up to 42 residents offering residential and nursing care. The accommodation is arranged on the ground and first floors. All rooms are centrally heated, furnished bed-sitting rooms with en-suite facilities. Residents may furnish their own rooms with small items of furniture, if they wish, provided that the furniture meets the required safety standards.

On each corridor there are bath/shower facilities especially adapted for safe usage so that residents maintain their independence in a safe environment. Kitchenettes are available where residents can make drinks and snacks for themselves or their visitors.

The Tithebarn offers a wide range of recreational facilities including a well stocked library with a full range of books to suit many needs. Social and other activities are an important aspect of the care at the Home. Residents are encouraged to remain active for as long as they are able. A full programme of activities is organised by our Activities Co-ordinator to include arts and crafts, entertainment, events and visits to various places of interest.

The Home has its own hairdressing salon where residents can enjoy haircuts and pampering from a professional hairdresser.
