How to find us

By train

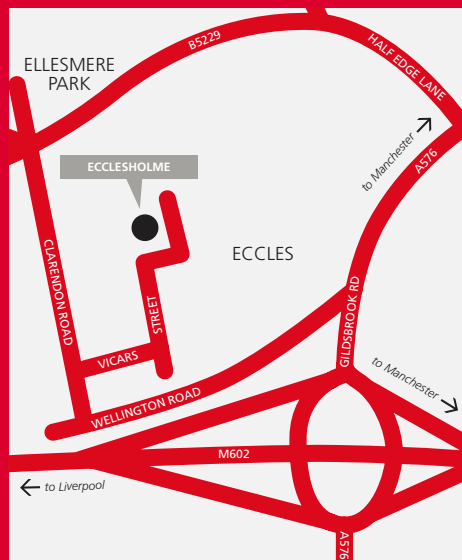
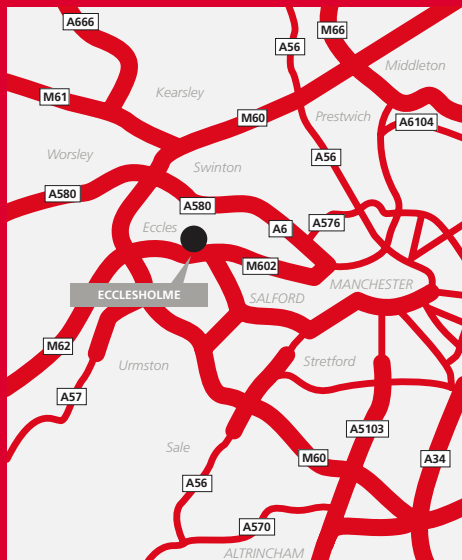
Eccles (200 yards). Ecclesholme can also be reached by Metrolink from Manchester town centre, where the main train station runs to all areas of the country.

By bus

Bus services from Manchester town, Irlam, Swinton, Warrington and Worsley terminate at Eccles bus station, which is a few minutes walk from the Home.

By car

From M6 Exit at Junction 21a (M62) towards Manchester. M62 (Junction 12) take M602 towards Manchester for approximately 1.75 miles. At Junction 2 (M602) turn left onto A576 (Gildebroom Road). At traffic lights turn left into Wellington Road. After 350 yards, turn right into Clarendon Road and then 1st right into Vicars Street. Follow Vicars Street to the end - the street bends around to the left - the Home is at the end.

Ecclesholme



Purpose-built in 1977, Ecclesholme is situated in a quiet and pleasant residential area close to Eccles town centre. This spacious home is set in beautiful grounds next to Elm Bank Masonic Hall with a central courtyard where residents can sit and enjoy the gardens and the sunshine.

The Home operates a traditional 'hotel' style of care, where residents share communal facilities. The categories of care offered are dependent upon people's assessed individual needs.

Here is a snapshot of our services at Ecclesholme:

General facilities and services available

The whole premise of the RMBI is to create a home rather than an 'institutional style' environment, both inside and out. Ecclesholme can accommodate up to 46 residents offering residential care. All rooms are single, centrally heated furnished bed-sitting rooms with en-suite facilities. Residents may furnish their own rooms, if they wish, provided that the furniture meets the required safety standards.

On each corridor there are bath/shower facilities especially adapted for safe usage so that residents maintain their independence in a safe environment. Kitchenettes are available where residents can make drinks and snacks for themselves or their visitors.

Health and personal care

Ecclesholme offers a wide range of recreational facilities including a stocked library. In addition, Salford Mobile Library visits the Home regularly. Social and other activities are an important aspect of the care at the Home. Residents are encouraged to remain active for as long as they are able. A full programme of activities is organised by our Activities Co-ordinator to include entertainment, shopping trips and visits to places of interest.

The Home has its own hairdressing salon where residents can enjoy haircuts and pampering from a professional hairdresser.

If residents have special dietary requirements, these can also be met. Residents' family and friends are also encouraged to dine – at a small charge.
