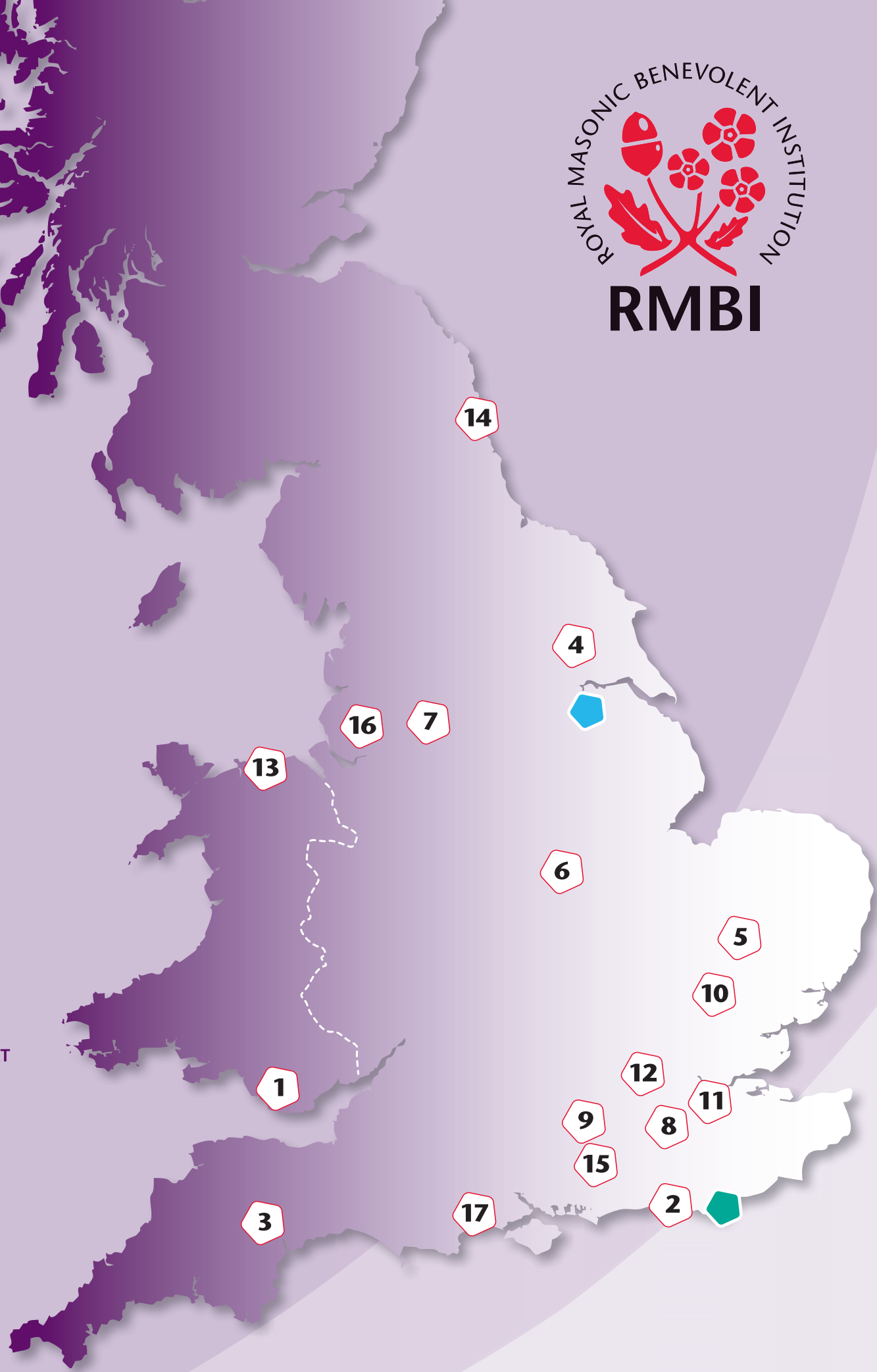

To apply to an RMBI care home, please contact the relevant Home directly or visit the website at [rmbi.org.uk](http://rmbi.org.uk). You can also call 020 7596 2400 to discuss your care needs.

Every potential resident is assessed to find out what type of care package would best meet their needs. A tailor-made care plan is put together which is reviewed on a regular basis.

RMBI services are available to people with either private or public funding. All applicants are advised of their weekly fee before moving into the Home. The weekly fee covers the provision of accommodation, meals and care. The fee may change as care needs change.
